

Business Loans

In 2018-19, **28** loan applications were received and adjudicated. **Twenty one** loans were authorized. Fourteen loans supported local clients totaling **\$659,222** and seven were syndication loans assisting network partners totaling **\$865,538** for a grand total of **\$1,524,760**, representing an increase of **26**% from the previous year. The remaining 7 applications totaling **\$783,000** were subsequently withdrawn or declined.

The average loan value for the year increased 12% over the previous 8 year average, this year amounting to \$63,823.

Over 78 jobs have been maintained or created through our loan program.

For 2018-19 the total loan loss for the year was .02%. Over a 10 year average the loan loss is 2.7%.



Self-Employment Services

2018-19 marked our **30**th year delivering the SE program. In the 30 years, **975** businesses were launched.

2018-19 was also a very successful year for the Self-Employment program. A record breaking **24** businesses were successfully launched.



Of those 24 businesses launched 70% of the business were female led. The overall average age was 44.

Parkville was the most active location representing 33% of all new businesses. Port Alberni came in second representing 29%.

Industries most commonly launched were arts, health care/spa and construction.



30% of referrals came from the website, showcasing that our SEO and content on the website have improved. In 2017/18, website referrals amounted to 17%; the least referred source for clients. Close second in referral this year was our CF network with 28.6% of referrals.


Vancouver Island/Coastal Region maintains the most active area representing 45% of contracts received.

Price Determination/Validation services remain the most sought after representing 54% of overall purchases.

60% of the services purchased were from business sellers. Men represent 57% of the market with couples following at 23%.

314 owners marketed their businesses for sale on the website.

Government programs impact website activity. In less than 3 months from the announcement of the new PNP, 165 views on our PNP services page had been received.



FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM






2018 marked the 3rd year that CFAC, in partnership with the City of Port Alberni, participated in the Business Façade Improvement Program. This program provides monetary assistance and design services as an incentive to building & business owners, to improve the character and physical appearance of their buildings. Façade improvements have significantly improved the visual appearance of businesses within the Community of Port Alberni. 27 Façades have been renovated since inception of the program.

In 2018, there was a significant decrease in applications. We believe the cause of this drop in applications was because the program marketing changed. 2019, will see a significant increase in social media to attract more applications.












Export Navigator helps small and medium sized businesses grow by supporting their entry into domestic and international markets. Community Futures Alberni-Clayoquot held the contract with the Province to support participating businesses in much of the Island Coast region.



After running as a pilot from September 2016, it was announced that Export Navigator will become a program effective April 2019. The program will come with a 3 year funding commitment and an expansion of service locations.
